Summer Enrollment is Now Open!



Spring Show Schedule

Saturday. May 1, 2021

The Spring Show will be held at the Edgewood Event Center

The Spring Show will be held May 1, 2021 at the Edgewood Event Center! We are going to run this show similar to our Winter Show, but with a few changes. We'll be doing several small-group shows throughout the day. The Performance Fee of \$20 per dancer includes **TWO** seats for audience members and is due by April 28th. Each dancer can have an **additional two seats** for audience members at \$5 each, but these must be requested by April 28th. There will be a livestream on all day so family and friends can watch live! Masks will be required for audience members and dancers while not dancing.

Dancers and spectators should arrive just 5 minutes before their show begins.

ALL costume pieces and shoes must have their name inside!

All dancers 1st -12th should come with their green studio t-shirt and sweat pants already on.

Bring the rest of your Studio gear from Rivals in a small plastic tote with lid. This system works SO WELL for dancers with multiple costume pieces, and it helps them stay organized!

Preschool & kindergarten dancers will need to arrive ready to go in their green studio t-shirt and black bottoms.

Hair should be pulled back off the face. This does NOT include JUST a headband. Hair MUST be secured. 1st-12th graders need to have their hair in a low ponytail. Preschool & kindergarten can do as you like. This can be a ponytail, half-pony tail, or braid.
