#### Welcome to December Dance Families!

<u>Costume Fees</u>
If you're a new student this season, please be sure to turn in your costume fee if you've not done so already! There are just a few outstanding yet, and those fees also go toward paying our photographer for studio pictures. If you're not sure if you still owe this fee, please send an email to the studio and we'll check for you.

All Fall Accounts Must Be Current

Please make sure your accounts are current by December 11th. If you're wondering if you have any outstanding tuition or fees, please check your parent portal. If you still have questions, please email the office.

Studio Pictures
Our studio pictures are THIS WEEK. Heather is going to attach the schedule (that was also sent out previously) to this newsletter in case you need a reminder – see page 2! I will be going over exactly what costume pieces are needed with each class this week. For all of our female dancers, there are no specific hairstyles this year; just please make sure hair is pulled out of the face with more than just a headband. Make up is also not necessary. For the preschool and kindergarten classes, one parent should plan to stay at the studio during pictures. They should move pretty quickly and dancers may leave once they are done. For dancers in 1st thru 12th grade, parents may drop their dancer off and pick them up at the end of their picture time. PLEASE do not drop dancers off before their assigned picture time and pick them up promptly - it is important we don't have too many people in the studio at one time.

Winter Show

I am SO EXCITED to finally get to present our winter show! At this time, the governor's restrictions mean that only ONE person is allowed to be in the audience for each dancer. Perhaps we'll be able to open it up to two audience members per dancer by the time of our performance - I'll keep you posted with updates. There will, however, be a LIVESTREAM available ALL DAY long so additional family and friends can watch the show live. Our show is being held at the Edgewood Event Center this year. Please see the attached schedule (which was also sent out previously) for your dancer's performance time - see page 3!. Remember - there is a \$20 performance fee per dancer (or \$30 per family if you have 2 or more dancers) instead of ticket fees this year; you may choose to pay this

fee any time, but it is due at the time of the performance. All of the dancers and our audience members will receive special Christmas cookies from Pie-Eyed and Flakey and Cafe Rose.

The studio will be closed December 20 through January 3rd.

The Winter Show will be held December 19th, 2020 at the Edgewood Event Center! Current Covid numbers in our area and government proclamations are going to keep us from having a full scale, full audience show. So, we'll be doing several small-group shows throughout the day. Currently, each dancer will be allowed **ONE** audience member! We are hopeful that restrictions will be lifted on December 11th and we can allow 2 audience members per dancer. This will help to keep audience numbers down, and keep the dancers in smaller groups backstage. Regardless, ALL of the shows will be recorded, and they'll be edited together for a FULL SHOW video to share with your friends and family! There will also be a livestream on all day so family and friends can watch live! Instead of tickets, there will be a performance fee for every dancer/family. Cost will be: \$20 per dancer **OR** \$30 per family. Masks will be required for audience members and dancers while not dancing.
