Studio Pictures

We are so excited to have the fabulous Jeff Barker taking our studio pictures once again this season! Studio pictures will take place the week of <u>April 10th</u>. Specific schedules will be detailed and sent to you by the end of February. Dancers will be photographed in full costume with hair and make-up done just as they will have for the show. Instructions on hairstyles will be sent out soon. Cost for the pictures is covered in your Spring Picture fee, and covers a full copyright release of all photos. They will be uploaded to a Google folder for you to download and print as you please.

All Accounts Current

About our Spring Show

This is without doubt the highlight of our year and we are giddy with excitement to show you how hard our dancers have been working! This year our Spring Show will be held at the Elkader Opera House on May 6th. In order for us to give all students as much stage-time as possible, we have divided our classes into separate shows. We know that our dancers love to perform their routines and show off their hard work as much as possible, and we are thrilled to be able to offer more seating and ticket opportunities by dividing our Spring Show into groups. There will be TWO performances: SHOW A at 10:30am and SHOW B at 2:30pm. See page 3 for the lineup of each show!

Tickets will go on sale on April 1st — and must be purchased from the Elkader Opera House's ticketing service, Booktix. To ensure our dancers get to perform and show off their hard work to a full audience, we have kept ticket prices very reasonable. Adult tickets are \$10-\$20, depending on location in the theatre. Children's tickets (Aged 4-12 years) are priced at \$8 each. We do not charge for children under 3 years old to attend, unless they will be occupying their own seat. This year, tickets to view our LIVESTREAM will also be available!

The opportunity to perform in a Spring Show is an exciting, empowering and confidence-building part of your time at our studio. This is where we love to watch our students learn about the theatre, rehearsals and teamwork while they enjoy the opportunity to showcase their skills in a professionally run production. Recitals are a wonderful way for students to showcase the results of their hard work and for family and friends to join in the pride of their achievement. We love giving all students the chance to perform for their family and friends in this supportive and fun environment, and encourage even our youngest and newest performers to be involved. If there is any reason why your child will not be able to perform at the Spring Show on the dates and times provided, please let us know so we can prepare their classes appropriately.

In terms of attendance, it is very important that students do not miss any of their scheduled classes between now and Spring Show time so they can spend their rehearsal time together to perform their routines, feel confident and look amazing. If for any reason your child will miss any of their regular classes, we ask that you contact us to let us know in advance. Please note that, unfortunately, any families with unpaid dance or costume fees will not be allowed to participate in our Spring Show. All accounts must be paid in full by March 26th.

Dress Rehearsals

Here at Fusion DanceWorks, dress rehearsals are a super important part of preparing for our Spring Show. This is where we get to see the costumes working on stage in a group to really compliment the dances your children have been working so hard on throughout the year. It gives us a chance to make any adjustments and ensure that everyone has time to get ready between their dances. We can see if any dancers are missing shoes, costume pieces, or other accessories.

Even more importantly, it gives the stars of our show a chance to get up and rehearse on the big stage – a very different environment than they are used to within the studio walls. They can overcome some of the jitters that may hit when the bright lights come on and really prepare themselves for the show ahead. It is a fun and rewarding experience and a great chance to play with their friends and watch some inspiring dancers as they wait for their turn in the spotlight.

Recital Week Schedule Monday, May 1 — Saturday, May 6

All dancers should arrive backstage by 10:00am ready to go. Show begins at 10:30am!

Saturday, AFTERNOON, May 6th - SHOW B

All dancers should arrive backstage by 2:00pm ready to go. Show begins at 2:30pm!
