I hope you all had a terrific Labor Day. Today is the day— the beginning of a new dance year! I have been looking forward to being back in the studio with these kiddos for the past 6 months - we have so much dancing to do!

For the new families at Fusion - WELCOME! Thank you so much for choosing Fusion for your dance family. I hope you feel met with care, good instruction, and a positive atmosphere!

For my returning families - WELCOME BACK! Thank you so much for sticking with me - you really are the greatest dance family. Even as things shift a bit this year, I hope we slide right back into our easy-going rhythm of the dance year and make it fantastic!

As far as policies and schedules go, all of those things will be gone over during the first week of classes at Open House. I've tried to simplify as much as possible this year - because I know all of us are dealing with a lot! I've listed a couple of highlights below::

What will be the same:

Class Structure - We will still do every part of our classes at Fusion! With a maximum of 8 students per class, we'll be able to use our space fully and well so we don't miss out on anything! *Instruction* - I will be fully engaged with each student throughout class.

What will be different:

No entryway seating - To limit crowding, the chairs will be removed from the entry way. I ask that adults drop their students off, perhaps take a moment to help their dancer transition, and then wait outside the studio. I have numbers for all the parents in case you would be needed.

No water fountain - Dancers should plan to bring a water bottle to class with them; we won't be using the communal water fountain this year. (Also - please remember to take your water bottle home with you!!)

I've been asked several times, so I'll let you know - I am not requiring masks on students right now. Any staff in the studio will be masked, and we will have windows open as much as possible to allow for fresh air until the weather no longer allows that. Also, if a family prefers their dancer to be masked, that is perfectly fine. Please know - this is a flexible situation, and we will roll with whatever is best to keep us dancing IN THE STUDIO.

As far as absences and quarantine procedures - that's all kind of heavy. Definitely doable, and hopefully not too crazy - but I'll plan to go over all of that with you during your dancer's first class. Don't worry though...all of that information will be available on the website after that first week so you can reference it as necessary.
