Open House Week Recap

For those who weren't able to make Open House night at the studio - OR - if you were there and just need a recap to refer to, here are the things to remember as we head into the year:

- Please make sure you are a member of the Fusion News & Notes group on Facebook, and make sure you're able to access the Parent Portal as well. If you have questions about accessing either of these important tools, contact Miranda ASAP.
- It's also a good idea to have the Fusion website bookmarked on your phone or computer.

- The Studio Handbook (which will answer LOTS of questions throughout the year) is hanging up in the studio and is also on the website.
- All of your calendar dates will be on the calendar in the Parent Portal. Please check that regularly. Paper calendars will not be sent home this year.
- All dancers in an hour or longer class need to have a pair of dance shoes and wear them to class each week. If your dancer needs a new pair, and you did NOT order them at class, there is an order form to fill out on the website (http://www.fusiondanceworks.studio/shop.html) and Miranda will order them for you.
- Dancers should bring a water bottle to class (and please remember to take it home with you!)
- At this time, students are not required to wear a mask. I do ask that parents wear a mask when
 they come into the building for drop off and pick up. Students are NOT to arrive to class early, and
 they should be picked up promptly.
- If you are not feeling well (for any reason), please do not come to class. If you are quarantined from school due to exposure, please do not come to class. Please contact Miranda if you will not be in class. Zoom links will be

available in the Parent Portal for classes all year long if you're not able to be in the studio.

New students will have a \$50 costume/picture fee this year, due by December. Returning students should be sure to try on their costumes from last spring. If they fit, you're good to go. If they do not, contact Miranda ASAP to discuss options.

 If you choose the Installment Payment option, payments must be received by the first class of each month they are due. Late payments will be charged a late fee.

Ultimately, we are all responsible for keeping us dancing in the studio this season! Please care for your fellow dancers - stay socially distant in the studio, stay home when you aren't feeling well, and bring a positive attitude to class.
